

# Roses

## Materials

Double knit wool in your colour of choice  
4mm or 4.5mm knitting needles  
Scissors and sewing needle

## Knitted Rose v1

**Cast on:** 9sts

**Row 1:** Knit

**Row 2 and every alternate row:** Purl

**Row 3:** increase into every stitch of every stitch (18sts)

**Row 5:** increase into every stitch of every stitch (36sts)

**Row 7:** increase into every stitch of every stitch (72sts)

**Row 8:** Purl

Cast off



## Knitted Rose v2

**Cast on:** 6 Sts

**Row 1:** Knit All

**Row 2:** \* K1, YO \* K1 (11 sts)

**Row 3:** Knit All

**Row 4:** \* K1, YO \* K1 (21sts)

**Row 5:** Knit All

**Row 6:** \* K1, YO \* K1 (41sts)

**Row 7:** Knit All

**Row 8:** \* K1, YO \* K1 (81sts)

**Row 9:** Knit All

Cast off



## Cast off and finish

As you cast off your rose start to take shape by curling in

Take one end and curl it into a rose shape

Tack it securely together using your yarn tail and a tapestry needle.

## Crochet Rose

### Materials

Size 3.5 mm crochet hook

Double knit wool in your colour of choice

Leaving a long tail for assembly, ch 28

Into 3rd st from hook, \*dc, ch2, dc into same st, ch1, skip 1, rep from 8

Ch3, turn work, dc3 into ch2 hole, sc into ch1 hole, \*dc4 into next ch2

hole, sc into next ch1 hole, repeat from \* 2 times, \*\* dc8 into next ch2

hole, sc into next ch1 hole, repeat from \*\* 6 times



Secure end and weave in. Curl up in a spiral beginning with cast-on tail end, sewing to secure until completely curled up

# Knitted Leaf

## Materials

Size 3.5mm knitting needles

Double knit wool in your colour of choice

**Cast on:** 3sts

**Row 1:** Knit

**Row 2:** K1, m1, K1, m1, K1 (5sts)

**Row 3 and every alternate row:** Knit

**Row 4:** K2, m1, K1, m1, K2 to (7sts)

**Row 6:** K3, m1, K1, m1, K3 (9sts)

**Row 8:** K4, m1, K1, m1, K4 (11sts)

**Row 10:** skpo, K7, K2tog (9sts)

**Row 12:** skpo, K5, K2tog (7sts)

**Row 14:** skpo, K3, K2tog (5sts)

**Row 16:** skpo, K1, K2tog (3sts)

**Row 18:** slip one stitch, K2tog, pssso (1stitch)

Cut wool

Secure the stitch by sewing it in at the top of the leaf

Sew in the end at the top of the leaf
