

Sun catchers

Materials

- Printed colouring sheets on white paper
- Water colour paints or permanent marker pens
- Cooking oil & cotton wool
- Lids (from used mason jars) or similar
- Glue
- Cord/ribbon

Instructions

- Colour the design and when dry, cut out the design to fit the inner rim of the lid
- Using a small amount of cooking oil on cotton wool, rub gently over the design
- When dry glue onto lid and use cord/ribbon to make hanging hook
- Tie to window frames or use suction cups to hang from glass
- Can also be used to create mobiles



Materials

- Coloured cellophane*
- Acetate sheets or clear cellophane
- PVA glue
- Lids (from used mason jars) or similar
- Glue
- Cord/ribbon

Instructions

- Layer the cellophane wrappers onto the acetate sheet or clear cellophane using PVA glue
- When dry**, cut to size and glue onto lid and use cord/ribbon to make hanging hook
- Tie to window frames or use suction cups to hang from glass
- Can also be used to create mobiles



* cellophane from sweet wrappers are ideal for this activity (but not ones with foil on the wrapper)

** to help dry quickly, use a hair dryer on warm setting – do not use too high a heat or hold too close to the design as this may cause it to curl up
