Home Support

Home Support provides vital practical support in and around the home to maintain and improve an individual's level of independence.

We can assist you with tasks such as:

- Respite for carers
- Bed changing and laundry
- Meal preparation
- Prescription collection
- Domestic Support
- Well-being calls
- Coffee and a chat
- Assisting to medical appointments and social engagements
- Lawn mowing and weeding
- Shopping - on behalf of, or accompanied by, the individual.

No personal care is provided.



Home Support provides:

- A service that adapts to your changing needs
- Flexible support that can be short or long term and available daily, weekly, or fortnightly for a minimum of one hour
- Competent, trained, and DBS checked Support Workers that are reliable and friendly
- A regular allocated Support Worker to ensure familiarity
- A service Monday to Friday 09:00 - 16:00.

Anyone aged 50+ living in Coventry or Warwickshire can use the Home Support Service.

Hourly rates apply.
