Main Tasks:

Our E-commerce Volunteers typically fit into one of the following categories:

1. Draft Listers:

- Assist in the preparation of donated goods for sale
- Prepare draft listings of items on our Online Shops (Currently eBay & depop)
- Basic stock management

2. Product Evaluators:

Research and estimate the value of suitable donations for listing online

3. Packers:

- o Package sold items safely and securely ready for dispatch
- Take packaged sold items to Drop-Off Points (EVRI, Royal Mail etc.)
- Basic stock management

- Providing a courteous and helpful service to customers
- Bringing to the attention of the E-commerce Manager or Assistant any concerns which may affect the safe and successful running of the E-commerce operation
- Assisting in the general housekeeping of the E-commerce operation
