Duties will include:

- Meeting the bus at specific locations for specific time slots (TBC)
- Talking to local people that approach the bus for information
- Giving out leaflets and talking to people about our services
- Encouraging people to sign up to our Friends of Age UK Croydon newsletter
- Providing feedback to the Comms Team about how the session went, any good news stories or issues
- Ensuring our leaflets remain well-stocked (informing the Comms Team to replenish)

Skills and Experience Required:

- No specific skills and experience, but the volunteer should be very confident and comfortable with speaking to the general public
- Willing to travel to different locations around the Borough of Croydon
- Training will be provided so the volunteer feels comfortable in talking about our services
