#### **UPDATES**

#### Carers' Survey 2025

Newham Council is conducting a survey to review carers' experiences of support and services, and to find out what carers think about services for the person they care for. The survey will be carried out by all local authorities and will be used to shape carers' services nationally. Locally it will be an important resource for the Council to identify what has been achieved for carers and to inform our approach to providing support to carers in the future. By carer, we mean somebody who provides 'unpaid' support or who looks after a family member, partner or friend who needs help because of their age, physical or mental illness, or disability.

The survey will be sent to a random sample of carers, 18 years and over, who have been provided with support during the year, and will run between 1st October to 30th November 2025, with the results being made available from Autumn 2026. If further support is required, staff and customers can phone the Survey Helpline on 020 3373 1520 (10.00-12.00 and 14.00-16.00, Mon-Fri ) to arrange for us to help customers complete the survey or for further information. Not all carers will receive the survey, instead a random sample will be chosen.



## WHAT DO YOUNG CARERS DO?

A Young Carer will usually carry out tasks because of someone else's illness or disability. These are tasks often carried out by an adult. A Young Carer may do one or more of the following types of care;



#### PHYSICAL/PERSONAL

Helping someone out of bed, helping with their dressing, feeding, personal grooming, toileting, giving medication on time, interpreting

#### DOMESTIC

Cooking, cleaning, washing clothes, washing up, ironing, shopping, paying bills, looking after siblings alone, taking them to school, collecting perscriptions



#### **EMOTIONAL**

Talking to someone who is distressed, keeping them motivated, safe, spending time with them, keeping them company, making them feel wanted/needed

#### **Carers Assessment**

A carer's assessment is a free evaluation offered by local authorities to anyone who provides unpaid care for a friend or family member. It looks at how caring affects the carer's life and wellbeing and what support they might need-such as help with respite, finances or emotional support. The aim is to ensure carers get the assistance they need to continue their role without harming their own health or quality of life.
