# OUR 1ST DONATION

In July we had an unexpected generous donation from an individual which has significantly helped us to raise awareness. Thank you so much for your kindness This enabled us to fund, **Dementia Prevention UK** who have delivered 6 brain health sessions to over **140** people.

A **7 week course** at Albany Leisure Centre in partnership with **BETTER.** More dates to follow.

We've delivered **nutrition sessions** with **Cooking Champions** and **Rozali** for improving health and cooking for people with dementia. **Headway Sports** held 6 sessions at Dugdale Centre as an additional offer.

We've been able to support local **dementia** cafes and memory clubs to support their weekly activities.

We held our first **Living Well with dementia** conference, introducing new innovation through speakers, tasters and stalls. 120 people were squeezed in and we are super grateful to Park Avenue Resource Centre.





Our bi monthly meetings will continue on 2nd Tuesday of every month. Teams meetings will be sent out, and we kick off on **Tuesday 14th January 2025.** 

Our new **Workstream Meetings** will be alternate months - and workstream members will feedback into the main meeting. Starting **11th February 2025.** Workstreams were developed from our planning meeting earlier this year, following the focus group held at Chicken Shed were we defined our priorities. They are as follows

*Workstream 1* - Raising dementia awareness across the borough (Objective One) and ensuring information is accessible for all (Objective two)

This will include supporting the implementation of new NCL ICB Dementia Friendly initiative and creating more Dementia Friends.

**Workstream 2** - Objective Three, raising awareness of how to reduce risk of developing dementia, Objective Four, ensuring timely and early diagnosis: and Objective Five : Contacting harder to reach communities.
