Homeshare: a trusted UK-wide scheme matching older adults with friendly, vetted younger people who offer overnight companionship and a little help around the home.

What is Homeshare?

Homeshare is a UK-wide scheme that enables two people to share a home for mutual benefit.



A Householder

Usually an older adult with a spare room who would benefit from company, overnight reassurance, and light help.



A Sharer

A carefully vetted younger person who offers 10 hours of support a week, while benefiting from low-cost accommodation.

Homeshare helps older people stay independent and feel safer at home, provides younger people with affordable housing, and gives families peace of mind. Both parties pay a small monthly fee for Two Generations' support and safeguarding.

Homeshare can be a good option if you:

- ✓ Have mobility issues or are finding everyday tasks more tiring
- ✓ Are living with early-onset dementia or mild memory problems
- ✓ Live alone and would benefit from a regular, familiar presence
- ✓ Have family or carers who support you, but they can't always be there
