Fountain Companionship:

At the beginning of October we were pleased to launch our new service – The Fountain Companion-ship Service. Designed to bring enjoyment and stimulation to people living with dementia, this service helps to develop and maintain an active mind. Meanwhile, carers can benefit from some respite. This service is operating as usual.

We offer this as a one to one service, in your home and we aim to do everything we can to offer this at a time that best suits you.

Dementia Outreach:

Our Dementia Outreach Service is also continuing to support carers who are caring for loved ones who are living with dementia via telephone, text, email and Zoom. This service runs 09:00 to 16:30 Monday to Thursday.

At the moment, Marc's focus is on our Meals on Wheels service where he has already produced a new and improved menu and ordering process, as well as moving to a fully recycled plastic container (pictured) in the hope it will be reused when possible. With a tighter fitting lid, more robust structure and clear top, this means the drivers

don't get messy leakages and you can easily eat straight from the container and microwave if necessary.

We are aware that some clients are not getting their meals as hot as they would like and we are doing everything we can to rectify this and make sure you always get a hot meal. This includes investing in new equipment for our drivers and kitchen. We welcome your feedback in relation to this.

Having worked with in the catering industry for over 30 years, Marc brings a wealth of knowledge with him. Most recently, he transformed the catering provided at Sainsbury's Head Office. Prior to that, he held numerous high profile Head Chef positions, including one at ZSL London Zoo!
