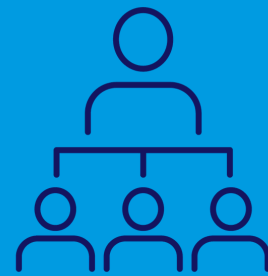


# What does ageing well mean to older people in your community?
