



Blue Badge Support Volunteer

Blue badges can help people remain independent and active outside their homes. Volunteers are a vital help to support people through this process

If you enjoy chatting to others, helping people in need and want to ensure our communities are accessible to all, this role could be great for you!

Role overview: This role will involve helping clients to complete the Blue Badge form in person. You will be enabling the client to express their personal situation to submit their application. You will be given in-depth training on how to complete the form and also on how to best support your client.

Location:

Working with clients in their home or at a community setting.

Time Requirement:

4-6 hours per week to fit around your existing commitments. Volunteer between Mon-Fri. 09:00-17:00

Requirements:

- Listening carefully to ensure your client's true situation is expressed
- Being able to make people feel comfortable discussing their needs
- Accurate writing skills are necessary, the form requires detailed written answers.
- Ability to travel and meet clients in their homes or a community setting.
- Commitment to training for this role and have regular contact with us.
- An enhanced DBS check is required for this position, this will be arranged for you.
