Role Overview:

Spreading the word -

Setting up -

On Friday 15th July we will be setting up as much of the event as possible. This will involve moving equipment, erecting gazebos, setting up stalls, refreshment area organised and general preparations.

Catering -

On Sunday 17th July we will need people to be preparing and serving tea, coffee and cake. There will be a system for collecting used cups and washing these to be used again. If you are a keen baker and would be able to contribute a cake this would be very much appreciated!

Help around the event -

The entrance to the event will need people greeting visitors, checking tickets and taking payments. We will be selling raffle tickets throughout the day and generally guiding people around the area. There will be stalls to run such as our childrens activities area and our vintAGE youth club with garden games. More stalls will be confirmed as we approach the event.

Breakdown -

General tidying up at the end of the day, packing away stalls, gazebos and removing equipment.
