

Homeshare Gloucestershire Opportunities







Opportunity 1 Cheltenham GL50

- 5 hours per week providing companionship and some practical support
- Ideally vegan or vegetarian
- A driver would be preferred
- Large single bedroom available



The Opportunity

To share a home with a friendly, chatty and very independent 55 year-old lady with cerebral palsy who would welcome the presence of another person in her flat. The Sharer would ideally be an open, friendly, vegan/ vegetarian, easy going, flexible, fairly chatty, tidy person who would enjoy the occasional chat over a cuppa. A driver and car owner would be a bonus. The Sharer would be expected to be in the property a minimum of three evenings per week as well as being home overnight.

The Flat


