But after visiting his local Age Cymru, Huw found out about the various groups and activities taking place.


He soon made new friends in his area and found a new lease of life, it's turned his life around.

How to leave a gift to us

I haven't written my will yet. How important is it that I write one and how complicated is it?

Writing a will is a crucial way to ensure that your wishes are carried out after your death. It needn't be a complicated process and it means your loved ones can carry out your wishes easily. We have lots of information available to help you plan and write your will.

How can I take care of my family and leave a gift to Age Cymru?

We understand that you want to take care of your loved ones first. But after providing for your family and friends, even a small percentage of what is left can make a real difference to the people who will need us years from now.

How easy is it to leave a gift to Age Cymru in my will?

It's very easy to include a gift to us in your will. If you already have a will you may not need to rewrite it. A qualified professional such as a solicitor can advise you on how to add an amendment (called a codicil).
