What to do if you have coronavirus symptoms

The current NHS guidance can be found <u>here</u> and advises to continue to stay at home if you have either

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough

To protect others, do not go to places like a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital. Stay at home. Use the 111 online coronavirus service to find out what to do.

Only call 111 if you cannot get help online: <u>https://111.nhs.uk/covid-19/</u>

For life-threatening emergencies, call 999 for an ambulance.

Everyone should do what they can to stop coronavirus spreading.

It's also important to wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds. Always wash your hands when you get home or into work and use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available.
