

A heart-warming story brought to you by Sophie, Jack's volunteer.

When starting out working alongside Age UK Reconnections I was so excited to see what it was like with the older generation, knowing the ins and outs of what life was like years ago. When I first met Jack we had a brief encounter while his key worker was with there with us and ever since then we have got on like a house on fire. Every time I see him he puts a smile on my face as do I with him. We've come to know how each other work and make a lot of jokes during our visits together.

Jack became unwell in himself which resulted in him not wanting to leave the house during a few sessions but soon became mobile when he felt able to and commented to me on one of the visits "because of you, I went out", this made my day. We always have something new to talk about or something new we can plan for the next time, whether that be staying in or going out for some lunch for a different atmosphere.

Jack said: "I would like to thank Sophie for all her kind help and thoughts these last few months. She has been a good friend and helped me through my bereavement. She has been a very good listener and I look forward to her company."



Jack is always up for new things, although the motivation is hard he still tries and even thought about swimming to help himself. I couldn't have been paired with a more pleasant, honest, lovely man and I'm so proud of how far he has come during the couple of months we have been in contact.

New LGBT+ awareness training now available!

Earlier this year, Age UK H&W's Training Solutions team delivered a new LGBT+ Awareness Training pilot session at Perry Manor Care Home, Worcester, to show support for and increase education of the LGBT+ community. Katherine Matthews, Home Manager at Perry Manor care home said:

"The sessions were designed to provide our younger colleagues with some historical context of LGBT issues, outlining some of the realities that were faced by LGBT people born before 1950, along with support on how to create an open, LGBT-friendly environment for residents and their families today."

The training pilot was developed in partnership with care home managers and LGBT+ group Out2gether. Nicola Longworth-Cook, founder of Out 2gether said:

"For older LGBT+ people the idea of moving into a care home can be very daunting. Older LGBT+ people will have lived through many positive changes in law and social attitudes, but they would also have encountered fear and discrimination.

The LGBT+ Awareness Training will help service providers learn how to create an 'LGBT+ affirmative environment' in order to give older LGBT+ people the care, security and respect they deserve."
