JOB PURPOSE AND ROLE:

The purpose of the Veterans Wellcheck Service is to provide person centred support to older veterans and provide them with information, advice and support to enable them to live as independently as they would like.

The Veterans Wellcheck Project Support Officer will provide administrative support to the Veterans Wellcheck team and be responsible for accurate data input, data quality and maintenance of client information. The job holder will contact clients to discuss their needs and eligibility for the service and refer to alternative services where appropriate. During busy periods, the job holder will also be responsible for carrying out home visits to conduct guided conversations.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- 1. Provide support to the Veterans Wellcheck service.
- 2. Contact clients to discuss their needs and eligibility for the Service and refer to alternative services where appropriate.
- 3. Produce and present information in a clear and simple format for clients.
- 4. Provide cover in busy periods to undertake home visits to carry out guided conversations
- 5. Arrange appointments for the Veterans Wellcheck Officers with clients.
- 6. Support the review of clients with the Veterans Wellcheck Officers.
- 7. Provide accurate and timely administrative support to the service.
- 8. Promote and publicise the service across the county.
- 9. Work within policy and procedure guidelines.
- 10. Actively participate in team meetings and work constructively with partners, staff and volunteers for the benefit of the organisation as a whole.
- 11. Any other duties as appropriate as requested by the organisation.
