

Easter bunny with a Cadbury Cream egg body filling pattern

You need

- Size 10 needles
- Double knitting yarn, any sort any colour
- Different colour yard to sew eyes and nose and white wool for tail
- Toy stuffing
- All in Knit

For body and head

Cast on 32 stitches

Knit

- 1. Increase in first stitch, knit 1 and then increase in every 3rd stitch to last 2 stiches
- 2. Knit 1 and increase in last stitch (40)
- 3. Knit 12 rows
- 4. Cast off 1 stitch at beginning and end of the next 4 rows (32)
- 5. Cast off 6 stitches at the beginning of next 2 rows
- 6. Increase 1 stitch at beginning of next 4 rows
- 7. Knit 4 rows
- 8. Knit 2, knit 2 together until last 2 stitches, knit 2
- 9. Knit 4 rows
- 10. Knit 2, knit 2 together until last 2 stitches, knit 2
- 11. Cut yarn leaving enough length to sew up head and sides and pull through the stitches
- 12. Sew up head and sides then stuff the head of the bunny and fasten off under the head (inside out)

For ears (times 2)

- 1. Cast on 4 stitches
- 2. Knit 8 rows
- 3. Cast off one stitch at beginning of next row
- 4. Knit 4 rows
- 5. Cast off all stiches
- Sew on the ears, eyes, nose and mouth.
- The Cadbury cream egg should be held by the body but you can sew tighter if needed.
