Help at Home

Whatever the reason that you find yourself less able to do things around the house, contact our Help at Home team...

The Help at Home service aims to support older people by helping with those tasks they may have difficulty doing themselves and thus enabling them to stay in their own home, maintain their independence and improve their wellbeing. This chargeable service offers our clients help with a variety of tasks, such as:

- Cleaning
- Shopping
- Laundry and ironing
- Helping to change beds
- Companionship
- Dementia Sitting
- Taking clients to appointments or social events
- Preparing light meals
- Helping with paperwork
- Having a cup of tea and a chat

(Please note we do not provide personal care)

To offer reassurance to our clients and their families the Help at Home team have a 'Never Walk Away' Policy – this is our Emergency plan that we follow if one of our clients doesn't open the door. We won't leave until we know where our client is – this could be by contacting next of kin, checking local hospitals, Carers or in some cases the police.

The service is available for anyone **50** years or over, living in the Hillingdon or Harrow Boroughs.

Homeshare



We have partnered with Two Generations to make Homeshare even more widely available for the benefit of everyone across Hillingdon, Harrow and Brent.

Homeshare is designed to help reduce isolation and improve wellbeing. It enables two unrelated people to share a home for mutual benefit.

An older person with a spare room (Householder) is carefully matched with a person who is in need of low-cost accommodation (Sharer). In return for accommodation the Sharer gives the Householder 10 hours of their time each week as a combination of practical support and companionship.

Each Homeshare match is individual. The type of support may include some light housework, cooking, shopping, gardening, help with computers and technology, or spending time together over a meal or a cup of tea.

The presence of another person in the house, especially overnight, will also benefit the Householder and reassure their families.

Hospital Support



We have teams of Support Workers based at Hillingdon Hospital and Northwick Park Hospital who are there to support you on your journey through from A&E to discharge.

If you are 60+ and live in Hillingdon our Discharge Teams can:

- Share advice and information on services available.
- Escort you home from A&E or a ward if you have been admitted.
- Once home we can help with small tasks such as basic shopping, emptying the fridge of out of date food, changing the bed, preparing drink and light snack, and the post.

If you wish we can call you up to three days post discharge to check all is well. You may like to have a home visit from one of our colleagues following your discharge to signpost you or assist you to access appropriate internal and external services.

We also have services at Wexham Park Hospital and Stoke Mandeville working alongside our Age UK Bucks colleagues to cover Discharge and Community Support throughout BuckinghamshireN

Social Prescribing Service



We play a key role in delivering the Social Prescribing service in some of the GP surgeries in Harrow.

Social prescribing link workers take referrals from GP surgeries for those in need for help with non-clinical issues such as homelessness, benefits, loneliness, and mental wellbeing. Social prescribing link workers connect them to activities and services in the community.

Upon receiving a referral, a social prescriber calls the patient to understand their support needs and identify sources of further support.

Community Support



Good Neighbours Service - Hillingdon and Harrow

If you require occasional/one off practical assistance or support such as learning how to use Information Technology in your home, attend a health appointment, sorting out paperwork, going for short walks or any other practical support that a "good neighbour" would provide, our volunteers can support you.

Simply contact our Community Team and let us know what task you need support with, and we will do our best to help.

This is very much an 'as and when needed' service for those occasional and one off tasks that you may need support with.

Some examples of tasks our volunteers can assist with include:

- Small domestic task / Posting and collecting letters/parcels
- Occasional shopping / Collecting prescriptions
- Short walks / Dog walking
- IT Support and training in the home
- Low level gardening
- Short-term telephone support to help reconnect/access community services 12-week support

All of our volunteers are DBS checked and our team are happy to discuss any requests you may have.

Face to face or telephone support with a volunteer for up to 6 months (Hillingdon only)

The criteria for social support is:

- 65 or over
- Lives alone, with no other support
- Mousebound
- Or have recently had a major life event such as bereavement or significant health event.

Falls Prevention Service



A physiotherapy-led service for people 65 years and over who live in the London Borough of Hillingdon or who are registered with a Hillingdon GP.

This service is for people who are independently mobile (with or without a walking aid), but are feeling less steady and are concerned about falling.

What we offer:

An initial home visit to find out more about your mobility, falls history and health issues that may affect your ability to move around.

We Will:

- Assess your home environment and give you advice on falls risk factors.
- Provide smaller items of equipment and walking aids to help you keep active and independent.
- Complete assessment tests to identify strength and balance deficits.
- Offer follow-up home visits to supervise exercises that will address deficits. Our exercise programme comprises up to 8 sessions working 1:1 with a member of our team.
- Accompany you outside whilst you build confidence.

We will signpost you to community-based activities and clubs so that you can continue to be active after you have been discharged from our service.

NB: This service is not for people who live in Care Home settings; or for people who have degenerative conditions such as Parkinson's Disease.
