**By car:** Take A315 Staines Road to Bedfont Lane traffic lights. Turn **left** into Bedfont Lane. Take 2nd turning on **right** into Southville Road, keep **left** on Southville Road until you reach the centre.

By bus: 116 from Hounslow alight at Bedfont Lane bus stop J. Walk down Bedfont Lane, 2nd right into Southville Road, keep left until you reach the Centre.

No.H25 from Hatton Cross. Alight at Letchworth Avenue bus stop. No.H25 from Feltham. Alight at Tachbrook Road bus stop N.
