 Someone over 50 who has made a big contribution to Island Business.

#### Age Friendly Contribution to the Community

 Someone over 50 who has devoted their time and effort to changing lives of others or who has impacted the community in a significant way.

#### Age Friendly Arm in Arm

 An older adult (or group of people) who work together across generations, or who contributes towards bridging the gap between young and older people.

#### **Age Friendly Impact**

 An older person who is selflessly making a difference to other people's lives.

#### Age Friendly Challenge of the Year

An older person who overcame a serious challenge and showed courage and determination to inspire others.

#### **Age Friendly Volunteer**

 Someone who devotes his or her time to volunteering and helping others.

#### **Age Friendly Team**

 A group of older adults who worked together to do something outstanding.

#### **Age Friendly Active Person**

 Someone who continues to be dedicated to, and passionate about sport, or who has achieved great things by crossing the finish line in an active competition.
