What is it about?

Islington Carers Hub holds a bi-monthly Carers Pathway meeting for all carers which is intended to develop an open forum for all carers, to discuss issues relevant to their caring role and provide an opportunity for the council to consult with them, (the forum is not the place to raise an individual or personal issue).

- To develop a voice for all carers in Islington in how services are delivered for both carers and the people they care for.

- The group will aim to represent the carers in Islington from a diverse range of backgrounds, ages and caring situations.
