How are you finding things at home?

- Stairs too much?
- Finding it difficult to clean or manage your garden?
- Wanting to move closer to friends or family?
- Can you move round your home easily?
- Do you have more rooms than you need?
- Can you still manage the cost of your rent or mortgage?





Future housing options

Making some changes at home

- Struggling at home or on discharge from hospital
- Occupational Therapy Assessment: specialist equipment & adaptations

What help is available?

- If council recommends adaptations free up to £10K depending on financial situation
- Specialist disability equipment & larger adaptations apply for Disabled Facilities Grant (homeowners and housing association clients only)
- If adaptations are under £1K and don't qualify for the grant, ask their Housing Association

How to get these?

- Talk to Social Services or Age UK Islington to organise an OT assessment (wait list)
- Talk to Age UK Islington about paid-for options for aids & equipment



Telecare and other solutions

 Technology that everyone can use that can help keep you safe at home & getting out and about

What help is available?

- Telecare red button pendant contact support in an emergency 24 hours a day
- Other providers offer similar services in sheltered housing
- Technology to send an alert for help if you fall, leave stove on, flooding etc.

How to get this?

- If you receive support from Adult Social Care, there is no charge for the service.
- Talk to the Islington Council Assistive Technology Team about paid options.
- Age UK Islington can make referrals on your behalf



Getting support at home

- Do you or someone you care for need support with everyday things getting up, going to bed, washing or preparing meals?
- What help is available?
 - Care needs assessment through Islington Council (wait list)
 - Decision based on national criteria only high levels of need will be eligible
 - Most of the support is means tested
- What paid-for help is available?
 - Ask friends and family for recommendations, or use Which? Trusted Trader search
 - Talk to Age UK Islington about ways to manage your shopping or to find local paid services to manage your garden or cleaning



Boosting your income

If you or your partner have extra care needs or are finding things difficult financially,
you can get a benefit check or help with managing debt

What help is available?

- Benefits check to see if you are receiving the right benefits / what you are eligible for
- E.g. if you have a disability or need supervision, or over state pension age & on low income
- Pension Credit is not claimed by many eligible people, yet opens door to other financial help
- Help with energy bills

How to get these?

- Talk to Islington Council Income Maximisation team (here today) or Shine Energy Team
- Age UK Islington can provide information & support to apply for benefits & help with energy bills

I want to move somewhere with further support

Sheltered Housing

For clients 55yrs/60yrs+ with mobility or medical needs who are struggling in their homes

What accommodation is available

- Self-contained flats, often with communal laundry rooms, communal gardens
- Safety? Concierge on site in working hours, 24/7 emergency alarms
- Waiting times currently up to a year, can request certain areas of Islington
- Residents eligible for housing benefit can transfer this from old to new address

How to apply?

- Complete a housing 'change in circumstance' form and 'medical form'
- Age UK Islington can provide information & help to apply, e.g. difficulty filling in forms
- Islington Council Housing Team will do an assessment by phone



Future housing options

- I want to stay where I am

- Other housing options
 - Seaside & Country Homes
 - Home Finder UK & Home swaps
 - General council / housing association properties





Seaside & Country Homes

- For clients 55yrs+ who live in social housing in London
- Priority is given to residents with greater number of bedrooms
- What accommodation is available
 - Bungalows & flats managed by housing associations across south coast, west country & eastern England – coastal and countryside
 - Some with private gardens, outdoor communal areas, peaceful purpose-built developments
- How to apply?
 - Application on Seaside & Country homes website / print off and post back
 - Age UK Islington can provide information & help to apply, e.g. difficulty filling in forms



General council / housing association property

- There is some general housing designated for 55yrs+ some of which disabled adapted
- Need at least 120 points to apply
- How to apply?
 - Need to complete a Housing 'change of circumstance' application or paper form
 - Copy of ID, proof of income, proof of 3 yrs (out of 5yrs) Islington residence needed
 - Age UK Islington can provide information & help to apply, e.g. difficulty filling in forms



Home Finder

- Helpful for people struggling to find accommodation or who are in difficult circumstances
- Provides help to find accommodation outside the local area
- In an average year 19 Islington families find a new home on Homefinder UK
- Who do they help?
 - Can help people who are homeless, living in temporary accommodation, people threatened with homelessness, victims of domestic abuse, overcrowded, ex-offenders, veterans
 - Case management service
- How to apply?
 - Via Home Finder website
 - Age UK Islington can provide information & help to apply, e.g. difficulty filling in forms



Home Swapper

- Social housing tenant renting from a registered housing association
- Home Swapper website average year 162 Islington families swap their home

Smart Move Scheme

Islington tenant in overcrowded property can swap with tenants with empty bedrooms

Downsizing

 Council property too big? Islington Housing Team can help you to downsize to smaller more manageable property
