INVITATION TO QUARTERLY CARERS PATHWAY MEETINGS

Islington Carers Hub holds a bi-monthly Carers Pathway meeting for all carers which is intended to develop an open forum for all carers, to discuss issues relevant to their caring role and provide an opportunity for the council to consult with them, (the forum not to raise or advocate about an individual or personal issue)
