Short walks are a great way to improve health and get to know your neighbourhood. We highly recommend a walk to the lovely Cally Park to be in nature this summer




# The Parent House is a listening organisation; we are here to support Islington parents

### **Spring Highlights**

Our **Parents united** group have visted local organisations to meet new parents, helped us with communications, designed leaflets and played an essentail part in recruitment and helping us to envisage some new work for SEND families. We are always hugely grateful.



We have worked with families of children under 3 at **Bright Start's New River Green Children's Centre,**where music therapist Seren led sessions to effect communication, sleep & langauge. One parent told us

'I enjoyed bringing the children together to learn through music, meeting other families, lovely staff very welcoming always made me feel comfortable. Will miss coming to the class.'

**SEND Friends** are a group of parents of children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). They welcome new parents to every session. This term they

have hosted CAMHS, Disability Action Islington and held a workshop with Crux about manging difficult conversations when navigating children's SEND journeys. A SEND Friend told us,

'The project has helped me gain knowledge about the SEND education process in schools and as also connected me with other SEND parents in the community. I have gained knowledge about local services, and I am able to share what I have learnt when meeting other SEND parents struggling with access to Information in the area'

'Welcomed from the moment I walked through the door'

We enjoyed sharing our building with **On The Record** who ran a course about the history of Islington childcare from TPH this term. They've created a podcast which you will be able to access on their website **OnTheRecord** 

We also worked hard with a CORE group from BIG Alliance to improve our communications, diversify our fundraising and create some plans to secure our future.
