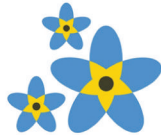

West Lancashire Dementia Hub is a unique, community based service with open access for local residents with dementia, their families, friends and carers and anyone who may be worried about their memory. A wide range of professional people and organisations are on hand to offer help and advice. All welcome, drop-in for a cuppa!

Dementia Community Links

Free service offering one to one support to those living with dementia or a memory concern and their carers. We aim to reduce social isolation, maintain independent living & provide opportunities to be involved in social, creative or educational activities.

Day Time Support service

Centre's in Ormskirk, Skelmersdale and Hesketh Bank where individuals can attend for a full or half day to socialise, learn or relearn skills and take part in engaging and meaningful activities. We provide a nutritional, two course meal with refreshments and snacks throughout the day (transport available additional charge).

Information and Advice Helpline

This service is free of charge, confidential, independent and impartial. We are able to help you with a range of issues. This may be about claiming benefits, housing, health and care issues or local services.

Timely and appropriate information and signposting from the point of diagnosis for the person living with dementia and those who support them. Our Dementia Advisers help you understand your diagnosis, answer any questions you may have and enable you to continue to live well with your diagnosis.

Dementia Support Service

Individualised support for Carers and people living with dementia providing information, signposting and support. Our Dementia Support Workers provide a point for all to turn and return to throughout the dementia journey.

Dementia Cafes

Open monthly meetings for people with dementia and carers, they provide an opportunity to meet with other people in a similar situation, meet new friends, access information, activities and share experiences.

Singing for the Brain

A weekly group held in Ormskirk, focused on the person living with dementia by using singing to bring people together in a friendly, stimulating environment.
