

Virtual Coffee Time Host

For a variety of reasons some older people cannot meet people face to face. This role connects older people virtually to others with the use of technology to meet new friends in a small group online.

Key Tasks

To help Age UK Lincoln & South Lincolnshire connect older people to online clubs and activities.

Supporting activities via Zoom calls with groups of people. Helping them with the use of computer equipment, facilitating a coffee morning/ afternoon

Providing that friendly human support to encourage them with new people, to engage and be involved.

Recording attendance and working closely with the staff team on this project.

Time Commitment

One afternoon session a week either Monday or Thursday.

Activities range from 40 minutes to 2 hours.

Skills required

- Great communications skills and confidence in managing group conversations online.
- Knowledge of Zoom and how to operate microphone, video settings.
- Reliable, good sense of humour, Good listener.
- Confident giving clear instructions .
- Willing to work to guidelines and policies on Health & Safety, confidentiality, boundary setting, and equal
