



Virtual Craft Club Host

For a variety of reasons some older people cannot meet people face to face. This role gives people the opportunity to take part in craft activities from their home.

Key Tasks

To help Age UK Lincoln & South Lincolnshire connect older people to online clubs and activities.

You will be supporting activities via Zoom calls with groups of people, facilitating a craft club

You will be providing that friendly human support to answer queries and encourage them learn new skills. This role is varied and determined by the need of our older community.

You will record attendance, working closely with the staff team on this project.

Time Commitment

One session a week either Tuesday Afternoon or Wednesday Morning
Activities range from 40 minutes to 2 hours.

Skills required

- Great communications skills and confidence in managing group conversations online.
- Knowledge of Zoom and how to operate microphone, video settings.
- General knowledge/interest of crafting
- Reliable, good sense of humour, Good listener. And confident with giving clear instructions.
- Willing to work to guidelines and policies on Health & Safety, confidentiality, boundary setting, and equal opportunities.

You will be volunteering from the comfort of your own home, using your own equipment.
