

# London Loo Alliance Manifesto

for the 7<sup>th</sup> May 2026 local authority elections in London



During these council elections, we are asking local parties to support our manifesto, which asks councils to commit to:

- Recognise the provision of toilets in public spaces as a public health responsibility.
- Publish a strategy for good public toilet provision and identify an officer responsible for its implementation.
- Plan to make public toilets accessible to disabled Londoners and people with long-term health conditions.
- Work together with all relevant bodies to coordinate signage and information about publicly accessible toilets across the borough and the city.

Before election day, the London Loo Alliance will publish a list of local parties supporting this manifesto.
