What is a Community Toilet Scheme?

- Allows members of the public to use the toilet facilities,
- In a range of approved local businesses and organisations,
- During their opening hours,
- Free of charge,
- And without any expectation that users will purchase goods or services.

Why are we developing a Community Toilet Scheme?

89% of residents said there are not enough toilets for the public to use in the borough.

There are only 22 toilets within the borough of Tower Hamlets currently open for the public to use, which is not enough to meet demand.

Good access to a toilet is very important for everyone especially for:

- The elderly
- People with disabilities or ill health
- Women
- Families
- Outdoor workers
- The homeless

A Community Toilet Scheme could benefit you, your business, and the wider community:

70% of residents said the lack of a toilet has stopped them from shopping or visiting an area in the borough.

- Increase footfall It can make your area more accessible and attractive to a wider range of visitors, residents and people who work in the area. It actively supports both the daytime and night-time economy by attracting customers back to the High Street.
- Create new customers You can widen the range of people who can shop at your venue.
- Free publicity Your business will be listed on the toilet map, giving you free publicity. This will be distributed throughout the borough and online.
- Improve your marketing You can use your inclusion in the scheme in your own marketing messaging.
- Improve local support Your local community will benefit from your involvement, and this will foster strong community relationships.
- Creates safer, cleaner, more welcoming High Street environments

Who can join the scheme?

- Pubs
- Restaurants and Cafes
- Hotels
- Cinemas and Theatres
- Shops
- Museums
- Leisure Centres / Gyms / Swimming Pools
- Studios
- Art Galleries
- Community Centres
- GP's / Hospitals / Opticians / Dentists / Pharmacies
- Religious places, like Mosques or Churches

How the Tower Hamlets Community Toilet Scheme will work:

- Register your interest: highstreets@towerhamlets.gov.uk
- The Council will register your venues toilet and times of access on the Toilet Map: Home.
- You retain the right to refuse entry in accordance with the law.
- Public can access the map to search 'my nearest loo'.
- We will provide a window sticker, posters, and other areas of support as required.

Here's a few more reasons why you should join the Tower Hamlets Community Toilet Scheme...

56% of the UK public limits how much they drink to avoid the trouble of finding a toilet when they are out of the house.

One in five people are put off from leaving their homes because they are worried about finding a toilet if they needed one.

43% of people with medical conditions do not go out at all because they might need to use a toilet.
