Cleaning Guidance

All toilets need to be cleaned, maintained, and monitored to avoid any harm to their users.

Viruses and bacteria in bodily functions can be harmful to health and can survive and spread on surfaces that are not cleaned properly.

- Clean toilets daily twice if in high demand.
- Use a cleaning rota and checklist to keep a note of what tasks have been completed.
- If you have more than one toilet, always keep one available for use.
- Refill supplies of toilet paper, hand soap, and hand towels regularly.
- Keep toilet maintenance outside of regular opening hours where possible.
- Start your cleaning from the cleanest area, working your way to the dirtiest.
- Use a separate cloth for each area of the bathroom to avoid cross-contamination.
- Use and store all chemicals and cleaning agents in accordance with the COSSH regulations. Keep out of reach of the toilet users.
