Our History

1970s

Age Concern has had a presence in the Medway Towns since the 1970s, opening its first Day Centre in Gillingham in 1974, and building a strong reputation locally for providing a range of quality care and support services for the growing older population.

2010s

In 2010, Age Concern Gillingham and Strood merged to become Age Concern Medway. In 2012, we made the transition to become a local partner of Age UK, adopting the name Age UK Medway. In 2018, we expanded our Homecare service to cover Faversham as well as Medway.

2020s

In 2021, we extended the support services we provide to include adults with learning disabilities, by adding Carers Relief Service to the group.

In April 2023, Age UK Medway formally took over operations of The Clarendon Royal Hotel, Gravesend, and began its transformation into a thriving community which offers extra care housing, respite beds and a hub of social and wellbeing activities.

Age UK Medway also took transfer of the services from Age UK North West Kent following its announced closure, helping to sustain the support provided to older people across the boroughs of Dartford, Gravesham and Swanley.

In July 2023, Age UK Medway entered a planned merger with Age UK Faversham & Sittingbourne following the departure of its CEO, as a practical measure to ensure sustainability for their vital local services.

In October 2023, Age UK Medway formally changed its name to Age UK Kent Rivers to accurately reflect all the areas across Kent in which its services now operate.





Our Services

Age UK Kent Rivers offers a wide variety of services for older people, and adults with learning disabilities, their families and carers, living in communities in and around Medway, Dartford, Gravesham, Swanley, Faversham and Sittingbourne.

Our services are designed to reduce isolation and loneliness, and to support people to maintain their independence for as long as possible. Whether it is specialist dementia support, help in the home such as personal care, footcare, meal deliveries and shopping, or support in the community, through social hubs, lunch clubs, and outings - we have something for everyone.

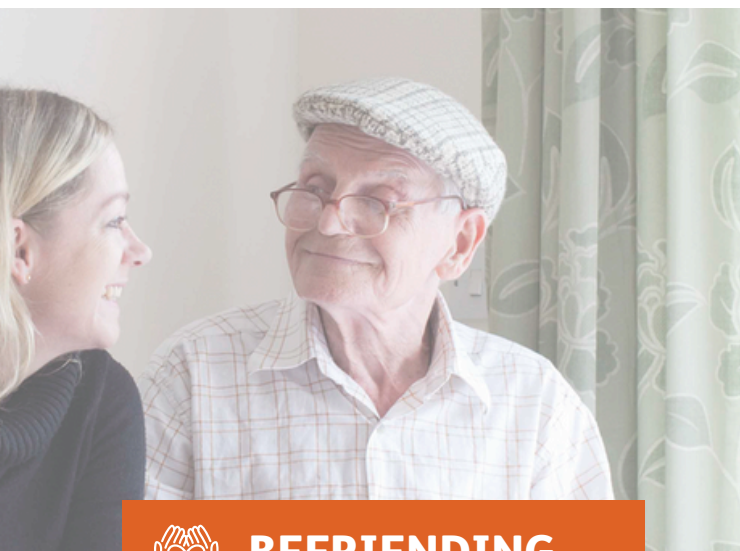

Age UK Kent Rivers' Befriending Service provides companionship to older people living in Medway, Faversham and Sittingbourne who are experiencing loneliness.

A fully trained and vetted volunteer will be carefully matched to an older person and spend 1-2 hours a week together, chatting about life and becoming not just a familiar face, but a friend.

The main aims of the service are to:

- Reduce social isolation
- Build confidence
- Maintain independence
- Enhance wellbeing
- Assist with engaging with the community.

Befriending is a free service, provided by fully-trained and vetted volunteers, who are carefully matched to ensure we connect people with similar interests and to create a long-lasting friendship.

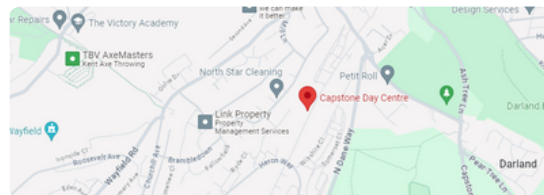

 - Interactive reminiscence

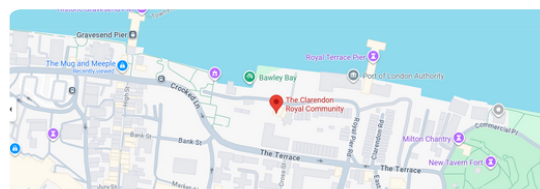

Dementia and Memory Cafes are regular social events, for people living with Dementia or memory concerns, as well as their carers and family members. They are hosted across various locations in Kent, as breakfast or afternoon clubs.

MCST (Maintenance Cognitive Stimulation Therapy) is designed for anyone experiencing memory problems, with or without a formal dementia diagnosis, and is run by qualified facilitators in a specialist therapy centre.

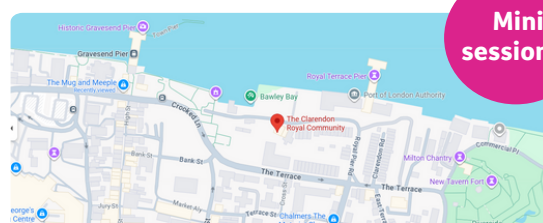
Cognitive Stimulation Therapy is the only non-drug treatment recommended to improve cognition, independence and wellbeing by the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) and our sessions are ideal for people who are concerned about their memory and want to proactively reduce their symptoms.

MCST sessions provide a place for individuals to address their issues with others in a similar position, and to connect with people who understand what they are going through - all whilst improving cognition through engaging conversation, thought-provoking games and quizzes, and reminiscence activities.

MCST is available as full-day sessions, and micro sessions, dependent on the location.

We are aware that cost can present barriers for some individuals that want to use our services, and that the cost of living crisis is having a huge impact on many people's financial situations.

The Welfare Fund can assist those who are experiencing extreme financial difficulty and struggling to access our services.

We know the type of support people need will vary based on their personal circumstances, and we are keen to help all older and vulnerable people to Achieve Life's Fullness, in whatever way we can.

The Welfare Fund is designed specifically to help those who are under temporary financial hardship, for example whilst they are awaiting the results from a benefit application or receiving support from Social Services.

The Welfare Fund is available to people aged 50+ and carers of/adults with learning disabilities living in our catchment areas*.

Bursaries from the fund are provided according to the levels of need and access to services being sought, and are designed to fill gaps left by temporary financial difficulties. We provide a safe, non-judgemental space to discuss your worries on an individual basis, and welcome applications at any time.

Applications can be completed by yourself, your Social Worker or on behalf of a qualifying friend/family member - just make sure their consent is obtained.

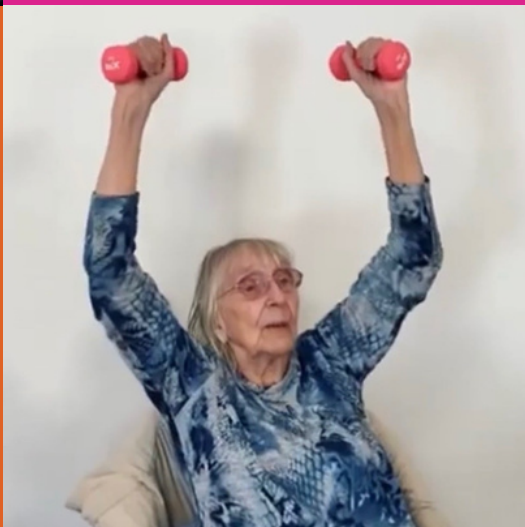
