To become a Trustee, you don't necessarily need previous experience as a Trustee or of the charity sector. Our Board of Trustees have significant personal and professional experience across a whole range of fields, including business, government, charity, finance, health and education. We continually strive for diversity on our Board and look for a wide range of skills and specialist knowledge.

We ask our Board of Trustees to participate fully in the governance of the charity, including attending the four Board meetings per year, plus our Annual General Meeting and Strategy Planning Day. Trustees are also asked to sit on one of our two quarterly sub-committees: Finance and Risk or Income Generation and Fundraising. Trustees support our fundraising, sponsorship and charity awareness through volunteering, promotion and ambassadorship.
