The **advocacy** service supports and enables people over 50 to have their voice heard. We can help you with making phone calls, writing letters and ensuring procedures are followed.

The **money matters** service supports and empowers over 65s to remain independent when handling the day to day management of household finances and paperwork.

The **bereavement advocacy** service provides support to people over 50 who are recently bereaved by offering practical help with completing paperwork and notifying companies.
