
Outdoor spaces and buildings





Main points raised in the free text

- Not feeling safe in darker evenings and so don't go out. Fear of antisocial behaviour and/or falling.
- Uneven paths and slabs causing trip hazards and difficult for users of walkers.
- Need shop mobility schemes in the area.
- Not enough access to public toilets around North Tyneside (particularly away from the coast).
 Toilets often in poor condition and not open long enough. Town centre toilets are in libraries as these aren't always open.
- Not enough accessible public toilets. At the coast, these are often down slopes which make it difficult to access.
- Would be nice to make an area of beach more accessible for wheelchair users.
- Parks not well maintained since government cuts.
- Not cycling on pavements.
- Dog mess.

- Greater access to blue badges.
- Covered shelters with seats at bus stops.
- Have more benches around North Tyneside. Benches at heights for ease of people with mobility concerns.

- Road drains are not regularly cleaned and often blocked creating floods.
