We can help you:

Our service will support you post-discharge, enabling you to regain your independence and improve your quality of life.

Working in partnership with the NHS, Home from Hospital bridge the gap between what the Health Service and Social Services can provide.

Your Age UK Coordinator will work with you to help you achieve your goals, and will maintain regular contact with you to ensure everything is running smoothly.
