Age UK Northamptonshire is determined to support the people who need us and we have re-organised our services and are redeploying resources to ensure that we can be effective. Most of our normal services have had to be suspended, but we are increasing our emergency support services for isolated older people with no one local to help them. We are in regular contact with all of our clients to find out if they need anything and how we can help.

We are working closely with Northamptonshire County Council, NHS Northamptonshire CCG and other local organisations to ensure that vulnerable people in the county are supported.

We salute the many fantastic people who are active in their community and are volunteering to help their neighbours and older people they know. We suggest you make any food donations to us and to food banks, and we advise people to contact established services such as the local council for help. Please err on the side of caution. We have increased the support we provide to older people in the county since the lockdown started. Since 17th March we have delivered 1,200 hot meals, 125 emergency food packages and 350 lots of shopping and collected 50 prescriptions in Northamptonshire, helping a total of 2,245 older people. This represents a 75% increase in demand for our services compared with the previous month. We cannot do this without your help. Emergency support services

- We are delivering free emergency bags of groceries and essential housing items to older people in need.
- We can visit the local shops to buy essential groceries paid for by the older person. We can also collect prescriptions.
- Our Telephone Befriending Service is for older people who would appreciate a phone call from a friendly volunteer.
- All our staff delivering emergency shopping and collecting prescriptions wear ID badges and are DBS checked. We will not ask people to hand over their bank card or PIN number.

We are continuing to provide regular, essential support to clients whilst minimising the risk to them and our staff.

- Social Prescribing Link Workers and Collaborative Care are supporting their clients in the community
- Our Handyperson Service is fitting key safes and doing emergency work.
- The Extra Help at the End of Life Service continues to support clients and their families. They are taking necessary measures to minimise the risks posed to them and their clients by the coronavirus pandemic.
- Our day centre staff are telephoning clients regularly and delivering meals and essential supplies to people with no support.
- The Hospital Support Services have adapted to the new circumstances and are providing support in Kettering and Northampton.
- Information & Advice Service is providing a telephone service.
