Health & Wellbeing Service

- We can provide access to a range of **activities** such as:
 - Best Foot Forward walks, which are guided health walks that take place in various areas of the city.
 - Men in Sheds, which offers men over 60 the opportunity to make friends over woodworking activities at a 'shed' in Worksop, Daybrook or Blidworth
 - We can provide details on a whole host of other activities organised by local organisations across the county.
 - A series of exercise classes for those who have experienced trips and falls.
- If you could benefit from **simple nail cutting and basic footcare advice**, our footcare service assists over 60s in Nottingham City (eligibility criteria applies)
- If you would like to **learn to use a computer or tablet**, ClickSilver is a computer course suitable for anyone over 55, providing one to one support to complete beginners or people with limited existing skills who need to gain more confidence in using a computer and the internet safely. There are two courses a year which start in October and January.
- We offer many opportunities for people who would like to use their talent and skills to improve the quality of life of older people, to volunteer with us. There are many ways to get involved; for example, visit an older person who is lonely and isolated at home; support less active older people at our day care centres; fundraise for us or help in our charity shops.

The Health & Wellbeing Service are also able to provide access to Age UK Notts specialist teams who can provide advice, advocacy, housing, and dementia support services.

Advice

Do you have an issue that you would value some information and advice on? Are you struggling to cope financially? Do you have a question and need legal advice?

Age UK Notts' Advice teams are able to provide free, independent confidential, expert advice on a range of issues including benefits, financial matters, trusted tradespeople, as well as refer people to other agencies that may be able to help.

We provide:



- Expert advice on welfare benefits, including checking you are receiving all the money to which you are entitled and help with making claims.
- Free initial **professional legal advice sessions** via a local solicitor on a range of legal matters
- We provide information on health, social care and local services.
- Our **Business Directory** of local reliable traders and businesses is developed with older people in mind. The business directory consists of over 150 reputable and trustworthy member companies ranging from plumbers to solicitors. All member companies have been checked to give people peace of mind.
- We can **put you in touch with other agencies** that can help.
- We provide a **Will writing** service to those who do not have a complicated estate. (£70 Single Will, £90 Mirror Will)

Dementia Support

Could you or a loved one benefit from a specialist day care designed with those who have dementia in mind?

We provide a **tailored day service** for people with a range of support needs including those with dementia.

This takes place at our Sybil Levin specialist dementia day service on Nuthall Road, Cinderhill (NG8 6AD).

The service provides **stimulating activities** (in groups and on a one to one basis) based on the interests of the individual as well as specialist activities including **reminiscence** and **cognitive stimulation** sessions. The service provides a home cooked meal each day which takes into account the individuals dietary needs and preferences.

In additional to the activities the centre provides a daily **bathing service**.

Door-to-door transport is also available (within an agreed range) via our specially adapted accessible minibus.

Housing

Do you feel cold at home? Do you have essential household repairs? Are you worried about having a trip or fall at home?

Our Safe & Sound team can provide:

Free home visits to carry out a home energy check, providing tailored energy advice enabling you to use energy more efficiently without compromising on warmth and with the added benefit of free energy saving products, you can look forward to saving an average of £37 a year on energy bills.

heating systems or support with eradicating damp and mould, roof repairs or upgrading old electrics.

- Subject to eligibility, we can access financial assistance for essential housing repairs including boiler repairs and replacements.
- A heater loans service for people with broken or faulty heating, loaning oilfilled radiators for a few weeks, enabling the home to stay warm whilst the heating is restored.
- In Rushcliffe, Broxtowe and Bassetlaw we offer the Warm Homes on Prescription service, completing home surveys and providing access to free heating measures like new A-rated boilers and radiators for people with broken or faulty heating systems (subject to eligibility)
