
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Health & Wellbeing Service

- Best Foot Forward walks, which are free guided health walks that take place in various areas of the city.
- Men in Sheds, which offers older men the opportunity to make friends over woodworking activities at a 'shed' in Worksop, Daybrook or Blidworth.
- We can provide details on a whole host of other activities organised by local organisations across the county.
- If you would like to learn to use a computer or tablet, ClickSilver Connections is a computer course suitable for anyone over 55, providing one to one support to complete beginners or people with limited existing skills who need to gain more confidence in using a computer and the internet safely. There are two courses a year which start in October and January.
- If you would like to use your talent and skills to improve the quality
 of life of older people, then why not volunteer with us? There are
 many ways to get involved; for example, visiting an older person
 who is lonely and isolated at home; supporting less active older
 people at our day care centre; fundraising for us or helping in our
 charity shops.

The Health & Wellbeing Service can provide access to Age UK Notts specialist teams who can provide advice, advocacy, housing, and dementia support services.



The Age UK Notts Advice team can provide free, independent, confidential, expert advice on a range of issues including benefits, financial matters, and trusted tradespeople. They can also refer you to other agencies that may be able to help.








We provide:

- Expert advice on welfare benefits, including checking you are receiving all the money to which you are entitled and help with making claims.
- A free initial legal advice consultation via a local solicitor on a range of legal matters.
- Information on health, social care and local services.
- A free Age UK Notts Business Directory with older peoples' needs at its heart. The Business Directory consists of over 150 reputable and trustworthy member companies ranging from plumbers to solicitors. All member companies have been checked by our staff to give you peace of mind.
- A Will writing service (commencing in 2022) to those who do not have a complicated estate (£70 Single Will, £90 Mirror Will). We provide contact with other agencies that can help.



Footcare

Could you benefit from a simple nail cutting & basic footcare advice service?

We offer people aged 50+, a simple nail cutting and basic footcare advice service. This service is available to people who have a long-term health condition, are not able to cut their own toenails, are registered with a Nottingham City GP and do not qualify for NHS Podiatry Services.* The footcare service includes a short soak, nail trim, the filing of hard skin, and the application of cream.

Housing

Our specialist Safe & Sound team helps adults living across Nottinghamshire to stay safe, warm and independent in their own homes.

Our Safe & Sound team can provide:

- Help with heating problems, boiler replacements and repairs.
- Oil filled radiators on loan for a few weeks while your heating is restored.
- Nottingham City & parts of the county
- 60+ (subject to eligibility criteria)
- Free advice
- Access to a cavity wall and loft insulation scheme for free or at a reduced price (subject to eligibility).
- Free registry onto the Priority Services Register, so that you become a priority in the event of a power cut.
- Free Home Energy Checks for over 50's with fitting of low cost energy saving devices such as radiator foils, LED lightbulbs and draught excluders.
- Free one-to-one scams advice sessions and booklets which tell you how to spot, avoid and report potential scams.
