Are you struggling to enjoy your later life? Are you lonely? Would you value advice or assistance to help you connect with people in your local community?

The Age UK Notts Health & Wellbeing service can support you to find solutions that will help you to remain independent and get the most out of later life. Whether it's housing, health, finance, loneliness or care needs, we can work with you.

Our staff and volunteers will put your needs, wishes & priorities at the centre of what they do. They will point you to local activities and services or, should you need it, they can work with you to put a plan in place to improve your life.

We can offer various types of support in different areas of the city and county.

 The Connect and Social Prescribing teams can help you find local groups and services in your community. We can work closely with you to find solutions to issues concerning you and support you to stay independent.

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 We can help you combat loneliness by linking you up with a volunteer visitor or telephone befriender. Our Connect team have helped over 13,000 people since it launched in January 2016 - could they help you?

- We can provide access to a range of activities such as:
 - Best Foot Forward walks, which are free guided health walks that take place in various areas of the city and county.



- We can provide details on a whole host of other activities organised by local organisations across the county.
- If you would like to learn to use a computer or tablet, arrange a one to one or group session delivered through our digital champions via our Digital Inclusion programme. A person-centred plan providing one to one support to complete beginners or people with limited existing skills who need to gain more confidence in using a computer and the internet safely.
- If you would like to use your talent and skills to improve the quality
 of life of older people, then why not volunteer with us? There are
 many ways to get involved; for example, visiting an older person
 who is lonely and isolated at home; supporting less active older
 people at our day care centre; fundraising for us or helping in our
 charity shops.


We provide:

- A free initial legal advice consultation via a local solicitor on a range of legal matters.
- Information on health, social care and local services.
- A free Age UK Notts Business Directory with older peoples' needs at its heart. The Business Directory consists of reputable and trustworthy member companies ranging from plumbers to solicitors. All member companies have been checked by our staff to give you peace of mind.
- A Will writing service (commencing Autumn 2023) to those who do not have a complicated estate. We provide contact with other agencies that can help.



Dementia Support


Could you or a loved one benefit from a specialist dementia day service?

Our SPECAL-Informed day service provides a unique, person-centred approach in the way we work with people with dementia.



- Help with heating problems, boiler replacements and repairs.
- Short term oil filled radiator loan while your heating is restored.
- Free registry onto the Priority Services
 Register, so that you become a priority in the event of a power cut.
- Free Home Energy Checks with fitting of low cost energy saving devices such as radiator foils, LED lightbulbs and draught excluders.
- Free energy saving advice and information.


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
Digital Inclusion Programme


