#### What is Men in Sheds?

Men in Sheds is a project that supports 50+ men who want to get together to share and learn new wood-working skills.

Age UK Notts provides the 'shed' (a workshop), tools and equipment and a team of volunteers for support - but the members take part in the day-to-day running of the shed and decide on activities they want to follow - including woodworking, skills sharing and socialising. Essentially, through taking control and ownership of the shed, the shed members are empowered.

We operate three sheds covering North, Mid and Central Nottingham which are based in Blidworth, Daybrook & Worksop, providing the tools and equipment. A team of volunteers and members choose activities and projects, take part in the day to day running of the sheds and the maintaining of the tools.

There is a wealth of knowledge in those who attend, from retired Rolls Royce engineers, train drivers, carpenters and veterans, all skills are brought to life and many new ones learnt.

Our members care greatly about their community and gain a great sense of achievement in knowing they have contributed a positive outcome through reusing, repurposing or recycling items that would have otherwise gone into landfill. The products, designed and created by the shed members, are sold to help support the Men in Sheds project.
