Mission Statement

Main Duties:

- To transport Hot & Cold Catering to and from Age UK Plymouth Centre to our clients as directed by the Catering Manager.
- Pick up meals (hot and cold food containers) and a route sheet from Age UK
 Plymouth Times instructed by the Catering Manager. Allow time for staff to take
 temperatures. Maintain correct temperatures for food by keeping food in the
 containers provided and keeping them closed during transport. Record
 temperatures of hot and cold food at end of route.
- Greet clients, and check to see that they are ok.
- Return empty containers to pick up point immediately after delivery. Notify your line manager of any problems or client needs.
- Comply with the Charity's Health and Safety policies and other relevant policies and procedures as contained in the Employees Handbook and as appropriate to the post.
- Support the Catering Manager with the administration of the Meals on Wheels service when required.
- To report all accidents, injuries or near-misses to the Catering Manager.
- To undertake any training considered appropriate to the post.
- To undertake such other duties as are reasonably appropriate to the post and to work flexibly to meet the needs of the Charity.

- Valid UK Driving Licence, own car & business insurance.
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Understanding of and empathy with older people
- Reliability and trustworthiness
- Willingness to undertake training appropriate to the role

Hours of work:
