The Role

We are searching for passionate and caring volunteers to join our Dementia Day Centre at The William Venton Centre, Memory Lane, Plymstock.

We run a range of activities within our Day Centre such as quizzes, learning new skills, dancing, singing, crafting, games, indoor sports, sensory activities, and much more. In the role you will be interacting with our clients, help and support the group lead, assist in setting up the room, making much needed refreshments and encouraging them to interact within the sessions.

Main Duties:

- Develop relationships with service users, their carers' and staff throughout the organisation.
- To pay attention to the safety and security of service users at all times ensuring that any issues are reported to management in a timely fashion.
- Providing a friendly and welcoming environment, ensure service users, their carers' and staff are treated with dignity and respect.
- Assist with facilitating the set-up of the service when required.
- Interact with clients, help and support the group lead, and assist in the setting up of the room.
- To facilitate activities in support of clients with cognitive impairment.
- Making refreshments and encouraging clients to interact within sessions.
- To comply with the Charity's policies and procedures.
- To undertake other ad-hoc duties as and when requested.
