EX-TRA is a research project studying the Mobility Hubs introduced on George Lane and Wanstead High Street (shown below). The project is led by the University of Westminster and collaborates with Redbridge Council and Living Streets, but is an independent study.

We want to understand what local people think about the Mobility Hubs – whether you live, work, own a business or often visit locally. Our team has been talking to people on the street outside both Hubs this spring, and we are running an online survey through which people are invited to share their views on the Hubs.
