Our befriending service has been supporting almost 800 people by telephone every week since the start of the pandemic. As people have become isolated due to shielding and self isolation, loneliness has affected so many people. Our amazing volunteers and staff make daily phone calls from our office or from their homes, for a friendly chat, to check up on their welfare, put them in touch with services they need and

help to sort out any worries they have. It also gives us the opportunity to inform them about the range of ever growing on line services we are providing to keep them motivated and to give them opportunity to chat with others on line.
