Who needs a DBS check? DBS checks help us make safer recruitment decisions. Volunteers who work in a "regulated activity" are required to undergo a DBS check. Activities relating to adults and regarded as regulated involve: healthcare, personal care, social work and assistance with financial or personal affairs. The definition focuses on those activities which, should they be needed by an adult, mean that the adult is considered vulnerable at the point of receiving them.
