Role Description & Main Duties:

We are looking for volunteers who are keen gardeners to coordinate a small team of our clients, who will be planting and then maintaining our allotment in Teddington on an ongoing basis. This role will be best suited to a patient person who does not mind rolling their sleeves up and getting stuck in!

Specific Responsibilities:

- To make a regular commitment to be at the allotment on specified mornings each week
- To be responsible for opening up the allotment (with the provided key), taking a register of attendees and closing up after the session
- To coordinate/assist AUKR clients as they undertake basic gardening in a group setting
- To liaise and agree with the clients what work needs to be carried out
- To be responsible for leaving the allotment clean and tidy, including bagging up waste if necessary
- To be aware of and implement relevant health and safety issues relating to gardening
- To attend any further training as may be required
- To participate in meetings for the support and benefit of volunteers

Person Specification:

- An interest in and experience of basic gardening tasks and good general fitness
- Patience and a good teaching manner
- The ability to work within a group setting as part of a team
- Able to communicate and have empathy with older people and people with disabilities and to be sensitive to the needs and wishes of an older person client group
- A sense of humour!
- Liking for and empathy with older people
- Reliability and trustworthiness
- A DBS check will be required

This role is for a 2 hour session on Thursday mornings.
