Role Description

This new volunteering role involves assisting our Furniture Warehouse Manager with a wide range of tasks needed to operate efficiently and successfully.

This will include representing Age UK Rotherham in face-to-face contact with members of the public so it is important that as well as being a team player, you feel comfortable talking to people and show respect for their property.

What will I be doing?

Be part of a team: -

- Serving customers and dealing with queries
- Helping on the till
- Preparing and pricing new and donated goods
- Assisting with deliveries to and from our warehouse
- Helping to create furniture displays
- Could entail practical tasks such as helping to refurbish or renovate donated items
- Keeping the warehouse and storage areas clean and tidy
- Researching items on the internet
- Completing paperwork and recording information
- Conversing with members of the public and giving a good impression of the charity
- Attending all relevant induction and training (including manual handling and use of lifting equipment)

Volunteers will receive information and support to help them operate within Age UK Rotherham's *Statement of Basic Principles* and to comply with the organisation's policies and procedures.

Skills Requirements

No specific skills or experience are required for this role but the following are desirable: -

- Well organised, reliability, punctual and trustworthy
- Customer service skills
- An interest in furniture and /or vintage objects
- Ability to lift and move furniture with support
- Friendly, flexible and supportive individual who has the ability to work with other volunteers and staff as part of a team
- Good communication skills in dealing with members of the public
- Willing to undertake relevant training
- Enthusiasm and an interest in helping to raise money for the work of the Charity
