

Hospital Aftercare & Reablement Support Service



Going home from hospital and need some help? We can provide practical information and support after a stay in hospital

Who is the service for?

- Salford residents, aged 55 or over
- A carer being discharged from hospital
- A carer supporting someone leaving hospital

Who can refer?

- Self refer
- Health or social care staff
- Family, relatives of a person who has had a stay in hospital
- Those with the relevant permission

When is the service available?

- Monday Thursday 9am -8pm (Friday until 7.30pm)
- Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays (9am - 5pm)
- Christmas Bank Holidays 9am-1pm

How do I contact the service?

Whilst you are in hospital, ask staff to contact us. We can see you whilst you are in hospital. If you have been discharged, you can contact us when you are back at home.

The service aims to:

- Help you plan your return home
- Ring you once you are home to check you are coping
- Visit you at home and complete a personal assessment of your health and wellbeing
- Offer a home safety check
- Develop a personal support plan to help you remain independent longer

Once you are home, we can:

- Offer (short term) practical support in your home; meal preparation, washing pots, putting washing in the machine, paying bills
- Arrange to do essential shopping
- Arrange and accompany you to essential appointments e.g. hospital, doctor, dentist
- Help you with meal planning and eating well if you have lost weight

We can also:

- Work with you for up to 6 weeks to ensure you have a smooth transition from hospital to home
- Work with you to ensure you have support networks to help your recovery
- Introduce you to other Age UK Salford services or social groups and activities
- Help you to think about and plan your future care needs

We do not offer:

- Personal Care
- Nursing, clinical care or therapy
- Medicine dispensing
- Financial or benefit advice
