Dementia Advice Sheffield

Our Dementia Advice Sheffield service provides a one-stop shop, first point of contact service to respond to any non-medical dementia-related query. This can be from a person who is living with dementia, their family carer or a professional. Our specialist advice workers will respond to your initial query and signpost you to the best source of information to meet your specific needs. This includes resources and services in your local community which can provide ongoing support.

Dementia Wellbeing Centres

Our Dementia Wellbeing Centres provide a full day of activities and support based on a Maintenance Cognitive Stimulation Therapy approach which is proven to delay the onset of dementia symptoms. They run between Monday - Friday with a person-centred approach designed for people with mild to moderate dementia.

Young Onset Support

Our Young Onset services provide information and advice, peer support, and tailored activities specifically designed for younger people who are living with dementia. If you want to join us, please get in touch.

Rosemary Memory Café

Our Rosemary Memory cafes provide tea, coffee, cake, and conversation, specifically for people living with dementia and their carers. The cafés are run from Dore Methodist Church, Bents Green Methodist Church, and Fulwood Scout Hut.
